

BERLIN-PATROL[©] **2019** will focus on the process of "Winning the Peace" among people in Europe and humanitarian achievements that occurred from the date of landing in Normandy on until today. Just 5 years after D-Day former enemies were engaged in providing food, fuel and hope to 2.4 mio. Berliners during the Berlin Airlift 1948/49. Already before that and before the Marshall Plan came into action Allied Troops had successfully installed functioning infrastructures, administration and relationships. We commemorate this process, meet veterans involved and visit sites of history as a farewell to British Forces Germany.

The 2019 Event will reach from former RAF Berlin Airlift Airfield Faßberg via RAF Airfield Lüneburg and City of Helmstedt to Berlin, where participants will erect the camp at RAF Airfield Gatow, today's German Air Force Museum. We will join up with the British Veterans of the Cold War Express:




Schedule

Wednesday, June 12

12:00h Starting arrival of green cars and crews at Lager Trauen (*google: Lager Trauen, 39, 29328 Faßberg*). Camp will be set up on the grounds in your own equipment and tents. Our Scout team will be there to assist you. Toilets and Showers are already there, too – so don't worry. If you were stationed in the area in your former life or if you like to drive around – we will recommend places – for example German Tank Museum in Munster (10km).

If you trailer your loved green one to Faßberg, towing vehicle and trailer can be parked on guarded area for the whole duration as long as you like until June 20th. If you decide to tailer your green vehicle to Berlin, please mark in the registration document. Details to be instructed onsite. Latest arrival that day at 22:00h. Late arrivals get access next morning 06:00h.



Thursday, June 13

08:00h Breakfast

09:00h There are many places to visit and we will provide information on all options close by or farther away and for any interest. It will be a day of leisure and suggested tours.




- 17:00h Drive to Bergen (Google: Memorial "Rampe Bergen" Bergen-Belsen,
 Belsener Str., 29303 Bergen 25km) and prepare for the arrival of the Cold
 War Express steam train with some 200 British Veterans and guests.
- 19.00h Welcome BAOR in Bergen with parade formation. Escort to barracks in Bergen.
- 20:00h Formal Reception for the veterans, evening mingle at Camp Bergen with RBL Bergen. Return drive to Trauen.
- 22:00h Arrival in Camp Trauen. Tabs.

Friday, June 14

- 08:30h Departure for Lüneburg (Google: Timelo-Berg, 21403 Wendisch Evern 60 km). British Veterans to be shuttled by Bus participating as one group.
- 10:30h Vehicle-formation at Timeloberg, on the grounds of 3rd RecBat. Tent with Exhibition on the German Surrender by Bund Deutsche Kriegsgräber Fürsorge.
- 11:00h Multi-faith multi-nation Service of Thanksgiving for all war-dead. Honor formation by British and German forces. Then transfer to adjacent grounds of Theordor Körner Kaserne, former RAF Air Field Lüneburg.
- 12:30h Lecture on the history of RAF Airfield Lüneburg and its role after 1945. Walk on historic grounds.
- 14:30h Drive into Lüneburg town (optional) for program (tba) and individual lunch. Lüneburg will be having its town festival that weekend and will offer great variety of options.
- 16:00h Return to Faßberg on individual routes.
- 17:30h Relocate BERLIN-PATROL camp directly to Faßberg Air Base aside the runway and parkway. Details to be announced onsite on previous day.







Saturday, June 15

- 08:00h Wake up next to the runway among vintage aircraft and have a coffee before 40k visitors pour in and inspect our camp.
- 10:00h Day of the German Armed Forces, static display of BERLIN-PATROL camp. Enjoy a day of visual and audio excitement! Flying displays, the biggest flight of airworthy Dakota in Europe since 1949, bratwurst, and 40,000 visitors. Luftbruckmuseum Fassberg is the only museum that deals with the totality of the OPERATION PLAIN FARE supply chain. 540,000 tons of coal was shipped from here to Berlin the only time in history coal has been air freight.
- 20:00h After program not yet to be announced.

Sunday, June 16

- 06:00h Wake up call. Take down camp and prepare to leave for Helmstedt.
- 08:00h Start to *Helmstedt Holzmarkt 130km*. The vehicles will either go on own wheels or trailer and will meet at Holzmarkt to be on display.
- 10:30h Arrival at Helmstedt Holzmarkt
- 11:00h Commemorational program with the Mayor of Helmstedt at Holzmarkt,
 Townhall, center of Helmstedt. Individual lunch at local restaurants.
 Helmstedt and its people will watch closely and participate in our visit.
- 14.00h Corridor Drive via Autobahn A2 with all vehicles Checkpoint Alpha to Bravo to German Air Force Museum google: *General-Steinhoff-Kaserne, Kladower Damm 194, 14089 Berlin* 200 km.
- 17:00h Start arriving in Gatow and set up your tent between historic aircraft in the German Air Force Museum at former RAF Air Field Gatow. Our scout team will already be there as showers and toilets and dinner ready on the runway. Access for late arrivals all night. We will have a splendid evening and inform you about the next three days of adventure.









Monday, June 17 (Tag der deutschen Einheit)

- 07:00h Wake up call.
- 08:00h Leave for Berlin City Center and join the British Veterans for a unique program. This day will focus on British presence in Berlin.
- 10:00h Brandenburg Gate for a group picture.
- 10:30h Welcome Back Tea and Biscuits Reception at British Embassy (TBC).
- 13:00h Olympic stadium and Museum West Alliierte in Berlin e.V. a unprecedented collection of allied history in Berlin run by a group of Berlin citizens. Get a Bratwurst, too!
- 14:00h free drive to historical places. A list of places will be provided as information how to get there.
- 18:00h After party.

Tuesday, June 18

Day of rest or leisure. Individual drives to historic points of interest.

Wednesday, June 19

10:00h Calm start into the day. Individual excursion or guided tours and drives to historic points of interest. Additionos to be announced.

Thursday, June 20

1 Eligible

1.1 All types of military vintage cars (wheels – no tracks), which

- in type were in service between 1945 to 1994 in the armies of the USA, GB, F, Soviet Union or Germany (Bundeswehr)
- are registered for use on public roads according to national laws and which are insured
- are in technical and optical good original condition to give an impression of the original former military standard
- carry fire extinguisher and a tarp or suitable equipment to prevent environmental pollution by oil leakage
- comply with technical regulations on speed on German Autobahn with at least 60 km/h (if not, they need to be trailered from Faßberg to Berlin on Autobahn A2 other routes can be used)

We point out that the camp site in Berlin is located outside the "Umweltzone" (ecological protection zone of the center of Berlin). Driving into the city of Berlin with vehicles which do not comply with oldtimer regulations (> 30 years) is against the law. Driving outside the "Umweltzone" within Berlin, in Potsdam and surrounding rural areas is possible. We will NOT provide special permits (Ausnahmegenehmigung).

1.2 Persons

Persons of any belief, age or gender and nationality, which are granted access to Bundeswehr installations according to German law (please see the attached list of banned nationalities defined by German Ministry of Defense). Persons under the age of 18 may participate under responsibility of their parent or guardian. Participation without military vehicle is only possible if the person is part of a car's crew. Participation as reenactor without vehicle is NOT possible.

We point out that the type of venue, program and dwelling will not be suitable for individuals with physical handycaps. If in doubt, please contact us before booking.

Meals provided during the operation will comply to German legal and military standards. We will not be able to expand to vegan or strict vegetarian food due to limitations in the supply chain. If you rely on a special diet, please contact us ahead. If you rely on special medical attention, please inform us upon first arrival at Camp registration.

2 Registration

2.1 Registration form

Registration of participants and vehicles is possible <u>only</u> by using the form "Registration 2019" which is attached to this document and which can be downloaded on the website <u>www.berlin-patrol.com</u> accepting these terms of participation. The recognition of these terms and conditions will be verified on arrival at the camp with autograph signature by each person.



2.2 Data protection act

The registration data will be processed by the operator and third party in the course of managing this project. Third party are Bundeswehr Faßberg, Bundeswehr Berlin, Bundespolizei, supporting members of USMVC e.V. and West Alliierte in Berlin e.V acting in his name according to legal requirements.

The operator is eligible to gather, store and process all provided personal data and to contact the registering party by phone, e-mail or print letter in any case coherent with the event. The operator must not use personal data for different purpose, nor sell to other party. Data will be stored in servers in EU.

2.3 Registration closing

Registration closes on **April 30th 2019 24:00h** or prior to this date, if decided by the operator. Such matter would be communicated in writing and made public on the website. **Maximum number of participating vehicles is 200**.

2.4 Price and registration process

Pricing for BERLIN-PATAROL[©] 2019

- 1. Vintage Military vehicle + 1 crew 300,00€ incl. VAT
- 2. Additional person each 50,00€ incl. VAT

The registration process includes the following steps:

- 1. Print registration form

- 3. Make full payment to EXPANDUM UG at Deutsche Bank IBAN DE89 1007 0848 0347 0226 00 and state "license plate number of green vehicle" in payment form
- 4. Receive e-mail confirmation with start number to your e-mail account stated in your registration form
- 5. Await further information by mail.

Participation in BERLIN-PATAROL[©] is to be paid fully in advance regardless of the duration of the individual participation. In case of unforseeable reasons a participation can be cancelled at any time. Cancellations have to be made in writing to scout@berlin-patrol.com and can only be done by the registering party for itself. Cancellations received until the 30th of April will be refunded the complete payment. Cancellations received after that date will be refunded 50% of the price. No-shows will not be refunded.

The operator reserves the right to refuse entries without giving reasons. In all cases of exclusion during the event due to violation of the terms and conditions forfeit will result in the order to leave the grounds without refund. In case of violation of regulations imposed by Bundeswehr in Faßberg or Gatow any participant will be under direct prosecution of Bundeswehr MP and / or Bundespolizei (Federal Police).

3 Arrival / participation / departure

It is possible to participate in the whole program as well as in single parts of BERLIN-PATAROL[©]. Please use the registration form to state your planned individual participation preference. For all individuals who are not part of the operator's orgateam the following timeschedule applies:

Earliest arrival in Faßberg: Wednesday, June 12th 12:00h

Latest final departure from Faßberg: Sunday, June 16th 10:00h



Earliest arrival in MHM Berlin Gatow: Sunday, June 16th 17:00h

Latest final departure from MHM Berlin Gatow: Thursday, June 20th 14:00h

The camp sites will be accessible under special regulation. These will be published to participants shortly before.

Participants who wish to arrive prior or who want to extend their visit can book public campsites or hotels nearby.

4 Registry / Security

On arrival at the camp site the vintage cars / pulling vehicles and trailers as well as the participating persons will be identified according to their given registration data. All participants will receive an identification bracelet, which has to be worn at all times until the final departure. At some program points it will be an entry ticket and serves for general identification as participant.

Vintage cars will be marked with self adhesive stickers on the wind shield. With this sticker they have access to the camp site / to the military grounds.

In camp Trauen and Faßberg Airbase all participants and especially drivers are asked to take special attention with **armoured vehicles** of active troops. During our stay personnel of other NATO forces will be present.

Security requirements on the site will be given and enforced by the operator and the military police.

5 Included Services

- General organisation for the overall operation
- · Starting number, travel documents, IDs, identification sticker per vehicle, identification bracelet per participant
- Registration, handling with Bundeswehr
- Provision of camp space in Faßberg and Berlin Gatow
- Provision of secured parking for trailers and pulling civil vehicles in Faßberg and Gatow (in Fassberg extended to 20th of June upon request)
- Toilets, showers, potable water at camps
- Electricity in designated areas to charge devices in camps
- Waste disposal (common waste of household living) in camps
- Maintenance area in case of need
- Breakfast (13.06.,14.06.,15.06., 16.06.)
- Dinner (15.06., 16.06.)
- Participation in the program
- Coin, antenna flag per vehicle

6 Accomodation / Clothing

Accomodation will be possible in participants' own military tents / civil tents or campers. Every participant will be assigned a space to park the vintage car, to set up a tent or camper. There will be a separation of military "green camp" and civilian "white camp" equipment. Every participant is asked to state his preferences when registering.

Wearing uniforms is not mandatory. Participation in BERLIN-PATROL[©] in <u>uniform matching the vehicle the time era or civilian clothes</u> are highly appreciated. General statement: if you wear uniform, make it authentic. No mixing of military equipment with civil components, no mixing of equipment of different Armies or nationalities, no phantasy uniforms. The operator reserves the right to regulate appearance and outfits prior to program points within the city and to ask for changes if necessary. Please keep in mind to wear suitable clothing for the service on the 15th!



Current uniforms with ranks, medals and honoring marks may only be worn / carried by persons eligible to do so (valid permission to wear ranks and uniforms of that army they represent). Since active military personnel, veterans and reserve units of different armies will participate the operator can order civilian clothes or the covering of ranks at certain occasions to those participants who do not wear proper ranks. In this case participating members are kindly asked to obey immediately to prevent misunderstandings with veterans or active military.

7 Supplies in the camp

Generally cooking and food supply is to be run by each participating party individually. Gas-, Fuel-stoves and Grills may be used to cook. NO OPEN SINGLE FIRES! Please keep extinguishers handy and act carefully.

On the camp site there will be catering offering beverages (beer, non-alcohol) and food at moderate cost. This will be run by the kitchen operator of the military installations.

8 Operation / garbage

Supermarkets and bakery are in reach by car as are gas-stations that sell vintage compatible fuel. All participants are requested to collect their own garbage in plastic bags which will be provided. Collection and disposal will be organized at a central point.

9 Security

In the camp there will be specially assigned helpers. Their orders are to be followed in any case. This also applies, of course, for orders by Police and Military Police, too. In the interest of the participants and of the event any single person not obeying the orders can be expelled from the grounds and the participation.

Medical service: there are first-aid personnel in the camp and the emergency ambulance is guaranteed by local hospitals. In any case of emergency please contact the operator's headquarter / command post on the camp site.

Speed limit: a good driver knows his limits! On the camp ground speed limit is walking speed / 3 mph. Every driver is responsible for his vehicle, his own condition and that of his crew.

No driving after 22:00h on the camp grounds. Exceptions are to be met with the operator / command post.

No loud music, running generators or other emission after 22:00h (Ruling of the local authorities for Environment) Exceptions are to be coordinated with the operator.

Minors under 18 years: parent or guardian are held liable for their action. Minors must not drive motorized vehicles at all.

Pets: sorry pets may not be brought.



10 Prohibited at BERLIN-PATROL®

- Wearing armbands with the word "MP Feldjäger", "MP" on the grounds is reserved for active Military
- Bringing, wearing, showing of uniforms, parts of uniforms and insignia of German origin before 1945 or of NVA
- Unconstitutional or illegal objects, emblems or speech or statements
- Statements, showing or distribution of material with contemporary political contents is forbidden according to the non-political policy of the Bundeswehr and the operator's code of conduct
- No weapons, fake weapons, ammunition, fireworks. During the 15th of June NO standing knife may be carried.
- Driving outside the marked ways
- Open fire in open single fireplaces
- Lumbering, debranching or destroying any plants, bushes or trees
- Driving cars around or running generators between 22:00h and 06:00h. Exceptions can be met with the operator.
- Destroying or damaging installations, theft of private, public or government property.

Disobeying these rules or failure of following instructions by supervisors will lead to immediate expulsion of the event and the order to move off the grounds.

The operator is producing a documentary of this event. All rights on movie, picture, audio content are property of of the operator. By entering the camp grounds every person complies with this fact and agrees to the regulation. Simultaneously the participant accepts the irrevocable, permanent right of the operator to deliver the content on any media, regardless of time, location, distribution channel. If participants do not wish to be filmed in close up they are to inform the camera team. Furthermore the operator will give TV teams the opportunity to cover parts of the camp and the ride.

Any commercial filming, picture taking, production of sound tracks has to be registered with the operator prior to production and have to be approved in writing. At the same time the operator can impose restrictions for commercial media productions.

11 Liability and waiver of liability

The operator declines any liability for personal injury or property damage that may occur during the event. Each person participates on their own risk in BERLIN-PATROL[©] and bears full criminal and civil liability for all injury or property damage that is caused by him/her or his/her vehicle. German law applies.

The operator reserves the right to impose all necessary changes to the event and its program if such are caused by force majeure or for safety reasons, or ordered by the authorities or to cancel the event if this is due to exceptional circumstances, without accepting any liability for damages.

At the moment of their registering participants declare their waiver of claims for damages of any kind which may occur in coherence with the event toward

- the operator
- the clubs "West Alliierte in Berlin e.V.", "USMVC e.V."
- the members of the central staff, camp command, it's helpers, supervisors and any third person or party who were
 engaged in planning, preparing or running the operation of BERLIN-PATROL[®] except for injury of the body or of
 health, which are directly coherent with an intentional or grossly negligent breach of duty
